At its hearing on Wednesday, June 28, 1978 the Local Branch of the Trial Division of the University Tribunal considered the following charge against you:

that you obtained unauthorized assistance and provided unauthorized assistance to another student during the final examination in PSY A01Y held at Scarborough College on April 18, 1978 contrary to Sections E.1 (a) (i) and G.10 (1)(b) and G.10 (2).

I am writing to formally advise you of the decision of the Tribunal with respect to this charge. The jury imposed the following sanctions for the academic offence to which you pleaded guilty:

- 1) that you be officially censured; and
- 2) that you receive a grade of zero in the final examination in PSY A01Y.

In the opinion of the jury the above sanctions were severe enough and should not affect your future scholastic life.

Finally in accordance with \$65 of the Rules of Procedure I enclose information recarding rights of appeal and the time limit in which the appeal must be filed.
