Appeal of a decanal sanction

Dear Ms. Lee:

The Appeal Division of the University Tribunal met on Monday, March 23, 1981 to consider your appeal from the penalty of zero that was assigned to you in ECO 203Y for admitted academic misconduct under s.16(5) of the Enactment of the Governing Council Respecting the Disciplinary Tribunal of the University of Toronto, 1980.

The Appellate Division of the University Tribunal dismissed your appeal. While commenting that the disciplinary procedures provide for a range of penalties under s.16(5), the Appeal Division indicated that it was not disposed to change the assignment of a grade of zero in ECO 203Y. In concluding that the penalty should not be disturbed, the Appeal Division remarked that plagiarism is a serious offence and that in your case the plagiarism was not just an incidental or trivial matter.

The Appeal Division's decision has been communicated to the appropriate University administrative officials.
