At its hearings on June 28th, August 4th, August 5th and August 12th, 1993, the University Tribunal considered the following charges against you:

THAT on or about April 13, 1992 you either did and/or attempted to intentionally use or possess an unauthorized aid or obtain unauthorized assistance in a term test contrary to Section B.I.1. (b) of the <u>University of Toronto Code of Behaviour on</u> Academic Matters, the particulars of which are set out below.

- 1. You were a student in PHL 245S.
- 2. Term Test No. 4 was scheduled for April 10, 1992.
- 3. You were granted permission to write the make-up test on April 13, 1992.
- 4. You brought with you you to the test on April 13, 1992 and submitted a copy of the test that was given to the students on April 10, 1992.
- 5. During the test on April 13, 1992 you attempted to obtain assistance from one of the other students writing the make-up test.

I am writing to formally advise you of the decision of the Tribunal. The jury acquitted you of the charges.
