At its hearing held on Thursday, November 23, 1995, the Trial Division of the University Tribunal heard the following charge against you:

THAT on or about April 17, 1995, you were a party to an offence under the Code in that you intentionally did or omitted to do something for the purpose of aiding or assisting Ms. N. , another member of the University to use or possess an unauthorized aid or aids or obtain unauthorized assistance in an academic examination, contrary to Sections B.I.1.(b) and B.II.1.(ii) of the Code of Behaviour on Academic Matters, the particulars of which are set out below.

THAT on our about April 16 and/or April 17, 1995 you were a party to an offence under the Code in that you intentionally abetted, counselled or conspired with Ms. N. another member of the University, to use or possess an unauthorized aid or aids or obtain unauthorized assistance in an academic examination, and thus commit or be a party to an offence, contrary to Sections B.I.1.(b) and B.II.1.(iv) of the Code of Behaviour on Academic Matters, the particulars of which are set out below.

In particular, in the spring of 1995 you were a student in NUR 306S. The final examination for that course was held on April 17, 1995. Prior to the commencement of the examination you agreed with Ms. N. that you would assist one another during the exam. During the exam, you assisted her by placing your exam paper and your body in such positions that Ms N could easily read your paper, with the intent of allowing her to read your answers.

The panel acquitted you of the charges.

Information concerning rights of appeal may be found in Section C.III of the Code of Behaviour on Academic Matters. The deadline for filing an appeal by the University is December 22nd, 1995.
